Itinerary Highlights:

Four-day Vienna Excursion- All students and faculty travel to Vienna, pursue a number of activities (exhibitions, museums, concert) and stay in a Vienna hostel for three nights. The excursion includes train fare, lodging, museum tickets, 72-hour subway pass, breakfast, and is included in the general program cost for all students.

Munich Day Trip- All students and faculty travel to Munich in the morning, pursue a number of curriculum-related activities (exhibitions, museums) and return late that evening. The excursion is included in the general program cost.

Free “Weekends” - Students are free to take advantage of extended travel opportunities during the 72-hour “weekends” built into the itinerary. Many students organize themselves into individual excursions to neighboring cities, especially Prague, Budapest, and Venice.

Lange Nacht der Kirchen - On this annual event, the churches of Austria open their doors and host a marathon of concerts beginning in the early evening and continuing into the wee hours of the night. Performances range from professional to students, and cover a broad range of instrumental and vocal genres. Most of the events are free.

Baroque Festival - annual baroque music festival in the Salzburg cathedral

Festspiele der Blasmusik- This four-day wind and brass festival features free outdoor performances on the Residenzplatz by a variety of brass and wind ensembles from a number of different European cities. Grab a snack and beverage and enjoy the free concerts!

Fronleichnam- This is a local Austrian religious holiday. Classes meet as usual, although the city of Salzburg celebrates with parades and evening festivities.

Concerts, recitals, master classes, class excursions, etc. - During the length of the Salzburg program, students have the opportunity to attend an enormous range musical events at various venues in the city of Salzburg, including recitals and master classes at the Mozarteum conservatory. In addition to opera, chamber music, solo recitals, *Liederabend*, and large ensembles, the Mozarteum regularly offers theatre and dance performances, as well as studio recitals for Renaissance and Baroque instruments, plucked instruments, electronic music, recorders, and even accordions.
